## A RESOLUTION

- Adopting a temporary Rule of the House of Representatives 1
- relating to powers and duties of standing committees to 2
- issues subpoenas. 3
- RESOLVED, That this resolution adopt a temporary rule to 4
- 5 apply notwithstanding provisions in the Rules of the House of
- Representatives; and be it further 6
- 7 RESOLVED, That each standing committee may issue subpoenas
- for documents or testimony. Notwithstanding any other rule of 8
- 9 the House, subpoenas issued under this rule shall be in the name
- 10 of the committee and shall be signed by the chair of the
- 11 committee and attested by another member of the committee who
- 12 voted in favor of either authorizing the subpoena or authorizing
- 13 the chair to issue subpoenas.
- 14 A subpoena issued by a standing committee may be served upon
- 15 any person and shall have the force and effect of a subpoena
- 16 issued out of the courts of this Commonwealth. Subpoenas shall
- 17 be served by the Sergeant-at-Arms of the House or other person
- 18 designated by the committee when directed to do so by the
- 19 committee. Each subpoena shall be addressed to the witness and

- 1 shall state that the proceeding is before a committee of the
- 2 House for which the witness is required to attend and testify at
- 3 a specified time and place; or to produce books, papers,
- 4 records, accounts, reports, documents and data and information
- 5 produced and stored by any electronic data processing system; or
- 6 both, as the committee may also require. Mileage and witness
- 7 fees shall be paid by the House to the witness in an amount
- 8 prescribed by law. A person who willfully neglects or refuses to
- 9 comply with a subpoena issued by the committee shall be subject
- 10 to the penalties provided by the laws of this Commonwealth with
- 11 respect to such willful neglect or refusal. The committee may
- 12 quash or modify the subpoena if it finds the subpoena to be
- 13 overly broad or without proper purpose. Each member of the
- 14 committee shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations
- 15 to witnesses appearing before the committee.
- 16 All such subpoenaed books, papers, records, accounts,
- 17 reports, documents and data and information produced and stored
- 18 by any electronic data processing system shall be returned to
- 19 the person from whom such material was subpoenaed when the
- 20 committee has completed its examination of such material. Such
- 21 material, or any information derived therefrom not a part of
- 22 public sessions of the committee, may not be turned over to any
- 23 person or authority without the consent of the person from whom
- 24 such material was subpoenaed; and be it further
- 25 RESOLVED, That, unless amended or revoked by the House,
- 26 except for the third paragraph of the second Resolved Clause of
- 27 this temporary rule, the temporary rule adopted in this
- 28 resolution shall expire upon the earlier of:
- 29 (1) the termination by executive order, proclamation or
- 30 operation of law of the declaration of disaster emergency

- 1 issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020; or
- 2 (2) the end of the legislative term.
