A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of June 2014 as "Corrections Officers and
2 Employees Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Corrections officers and employees form the backbone
4 of the correctional system of this Commonwealth; and

5 WHEREAS, Corrections officers and employees face the
6 possibility of harm every day they report for work; and

7 WHEREAS, Corrections officers and employees are charged with
8 the care, custody and control of our prison population and, as
9 such, are the first element in the rehabilitation of
10 incarcerated persons; and

11 WHEREAS, Corrections officers and employees are actively
12 involved in their communities through volunteer service and
13 civic participation; and

14 WHEREAS, Corrections officers and employees continue to work

1 effectively with prison officials to create well-run
2 correctional facilities, foster teamwork and support an
3 effective detention system; therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
5 month of June 2014 as "Corrections Officers and Employees Month"
6 in Pennsylvania in recognition of the valuable contributions of
7 these fine professionals.
