A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of June 1 through 5, 2020, as "Child Welfare Professionals Appreciation Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Every day in this Commonwealth, thousands of
- 4 children are at risk of child abuse and neglect or have been
- 5 removed from their homes due to abuse and neglect; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth recognizes the risks and the need
- 7 to protect children in this Commonwealth; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The challenging task of investigating child abuse,
- 9 providing services to families, assessing safety and providing
- 10 services to ensure that this Commonwealth's children are given
- 11 nurturance, family connections, support as they transition into
- 12 adulthood and services that allow children to remain safely in
- 13 their homes or return home as expeditiously as possible, falls
- 14 to the child welfare professionals of the Commonwealth's child
- 15 welfare system; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The work of child welfare professionals may require

- 1 them to enter into situations in which their personal safety may
- 2 be put at risk; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Child welfare professionals work in difficult and
- 4 emotional situations with children who have been victimized by
- 5 physical abuse, sexual abuse, neglect and other forms of
- 6 maltreatment; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Child welfare professionals must develop great skill
- 8 in working with families who are in crisis situations,
- 9 struggling with mental health challenges and suffering from drug
- 10 and alcohol conditions, poverty and other difficult issues; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Child welfare professionals must develop substantial
- 12 knowledge and skills surrounding the rights of families, the
- 13 laws surrounding child welfare and the legal processes governing
- 14 the child welfare system; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Child welfare professionals selflessly undertake the
- 16 endeavor to protect this Commonwealth's children, often with low
- 17 pay, long hours, tremendous demands, little appreciation and
- 18 great criticism, all of which has a dramatic impact on their
- 19 personal lives; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Every year child welfare professionals are injured
- 21 or killed in their pursuit to protect children across the United
- 22 States; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Innumerable injuries and deaths of children have
- 24 been averted due to the efforts of child welfare professionals;
- 25 therefore be it
- 26 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 27 week of June 1 through 5, 2020, as "Child Welfare Professionals
- 28 Appreciation Week" in Pennsylvania.
