A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of May 6 through 12, 2018, as "National Travel and Tourism Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The week of May 6 through 12, 2018, has been
- 4 selected as "National Travel and Tourism Week" by the U.S.
- 5 Travel Association; and
- 6 WHEREAS, "National Tourism Week" was established in 1983 when
- 7 the Congress of the United States passed a joint resolution
- 8 designating a week in May 1984 as "National Tourism Week" and,
- 9 in a White House ceremony, the President of the United States
- 10 signed a Presidential proclamation urging citizens to observe
- 11 the week with appropriate ceremonies and activities; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The theme of this year's celebration of the positive
- 13 impact travel and tourism has on the United States economy and
- 14 the lives of Americans is "Travel Then and Now"; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Tourism is one of Pennsylvania's largest industries

- 1 and a major contributor to the economy of this Commonwealth,
- 2 accounting for an annual economic impact of nearly \$42 billion;
- 3 and
- WHEREAS, Tourism supports a work force of more than 503,000
- 5 people, with approximately 1 out of every 15 Pennsylvania jobs
- 6 relying on travel and tourism and related industries; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is one of the most-visited states in
- 8 the country, with an estimated 203 million domestic and
- 9 international visits annually; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize May 6
- 11 through 12, 2018, as "National Travel and Tourism Week" in
- 12 Pennsylvania.
