A RESOLUTION

Directing the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to 1 conduct a study and issue a report on teacher preparatory schools. 3 WHEREAS, It is vital to modernize and improve the system of 4 5 preparing teachers and holding teacher preparatory schools 6 accountable for the investments made by the Commonwealth; and 7 WHEREAS, Every student deserves an education in which investments are made to ensure that the proper training of 8 teachers exists, which is critical to the success of students 10 and teachers alike; and 11 WHEREAS, The Department of Education finds that high-quality 12 teacher preparation has a greater impact on student learning 13 than other factors; and 14 WHEREAS, Research confirms that the most important in-school 15 factor in a student's success is a strong teacher; and 16 WHEREAS, A recent study conducted by the United States Department of Education finds that when teachers were asked 17

whether they were prepared when they entered their profession, a

- 1 majority indicated that they were not; and
- 2 WHEREAS, New standards need to be introduced to better
- 3 prepare teachers for their professional career in order to
- 4 better enhance learning outcomes; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Teacher preparation helps candidates develop the
- 6 knowledge and skills that they need in the classroom; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The American Educational Research Association finds
- 8 that collaborative arrangements between university programs and
- 9 local school districts have a positive impact on K-12 students
- 10 in measurable ways, including increases in standardized test
- 11 scores; therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the
- 13 Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to conduct a study and
- 14 issue a report on teacher preparatory schools; and be it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That the report include a review of current laws
- 16 and regulations of the Commonwealth regarding teacher
- 17 preparatory schools compared with the current laws and
- 18 regulations of other states; and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
- 20 submit the report containing its findings and recommendations to
- 21 the House of Representatives no later than six months after the
- 22 adoption of this resolution.
