A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the week of April 23 through 29, 2023, as "National Infertility Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, One in eight couples is affected by infertility in
- 4 the United States; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Infertility is defined as the inability to conceive
- 6 after one year or longer of unprotected sexual intercourse; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Infertility affects individuals of all ages, genders
- 8 and races; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Men and women can both contribute to infertility;
- 10 and
- 11 WHEREAS, Male infertility is a factor in roughly 50% of all
- 12 infertility cases; and
- 13 WHEREAS, In the United States, 9% of men and 11% of women
- 14 have experienced fertility issues; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Stigma is considered the burden of infertility; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Infertility can cause psychological distress,
- 17 emotional stress and financial difficulties for couples; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Couples can experience feelings of anger, guilt,
- 2 sadness, depression, anxiety and a loss of self-confidence and
- 3 self-esteem; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The most common types of fertility treatment are in
- 5 vitro fertilization (IVF) and intrauterine insemination (IUI);
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, IVF is the process of taking eggs from ovaries and
- 8 fertilizing them by sperm in a lab, with the result of an embryo
- 9 that can be implanted into a uterus; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The average cost of IVF in the United States is
- 11 currently \$11,000 to \$12,000 for one cycle; and
- 12 WHEREAS, IUI is the process of collecting healthy sperm and
- 13 inserting the sperm directly into the uterus when an individual
- 14 is ovulating; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The average cost of IUI in the United States is \$300
- 16 to \$1,000; and
- 17 WHEREAS, In 2019, 71% of women who went through IVF had no
- 18 fertility treatment coverage; and
- 19 WHEREAS, As of June 2022, there are 20 states that have
- 20 fertility insurance coverage laws, Pennsylvania is not one; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Raising awareness for the community of infertility
- 22 can remove barriers to care; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Educating others on infertility can remove the
- 24 stigma and increase empathy and sympathy towards those facing
- 25 infertility problems; and
- 26 WHEREAS, Infertility awareness is a vital part of normalizing
- 27 the conversation about difficulties with fertility; therefore be
- 28 it
