A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the 100th anniversary of the formation of the Mt.
2 Lebanon Fire Department and honoring the department on this
3 momentous and important occasion.

4 WHEREAS, The Mt. Lebanon Fire Department (MLFD) was
5 originally formed as a volunteer fire department on June 1,
6 1918, when a special committee reported to the Mt. Lebanon
7 Commission, verbally advising the commission of proposed plans
8 for the organization of a volunteer fire department; and

9 WHEREAS, The department was reorganized as the MLFD on
10 February 9, 1920, at the request of the Mt. Lebanon Commission,
11 and the volunteer department was officially chartered by the
12 Court of Common Pleas of Allegheny County on May 20, 1939; and

13 WHEREAS, The MLFD has become a premier provider of fire and
14 emergency services; and

15 WHEREAS, The MLFD consists of 17 full-time staff and
16 approximately 50 volunteers; and

17 WHEREAS, The MLFD is one of only two fire departments in this

1 Commonwealth that are currently accredited by the Commission on
2 Fire Accreditation International, which affirms the high
3 standards and best management practices of the MLFD; and

4 WHEREAS, The MLFD continues to be one of approximately 200
5 fire departments nationally to have obtained a Class 1 Insurance
6 Services Office Public Protection Classification; and

7 WHEREAS, Responding to an average of 2,000 calls for help
8 each year, the MLFD is extremely well respected for its services
9 inside and outside Mt. Lebanon; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
11 100th anniversary of the formation of the Mt. Lebanon Fire
12 Department and honor the department on this momentous and
13 important occasion; and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the men and
15 women who built the Mt. Lebanon Fire Department and who continue
16 to serve; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the Mt.
18 Lebanon community as a whole for the steadfast support of
19 developing and maintaining such a high-level fire department
20 over the past 100 years.
