A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of April 13 through 17, 2015, as "Local 2
 - Government Week" and April 15, 2015, as "Local Government
- Day" in Pennsylvania. 3
- WHEREAS, Local government in Pennsylvania is a mosaic of more
- than 4,500 individual units with 67 counties, more than 50 5
- cities, nearly 1,500 townships of the second class, nearly 100
- townships of the first class, more than 950 boroughs, one
- incorporated town, 500 school districts and more than 1,500
- authorities; and
- 10 WHEREAS, More than 12,000,000 Pennsylvania residents rely on
- 11 the services and facilities provided by local government,
- 12 ranging from the special purpose functions of counties, school
- 13 districts and municipal authorities in the areas of judicial
- 14 administration, social welfare, education and provision of water

- 1 and sewer services to the more general purpose functions of
- 2 cities, boroughs, towns and townships, such as maintenance of
- 3 roads and streets, police and fire protection and enforcement of
- 4 ordinances and land use controls; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Local government comprises thousands of hardworking
- 6 citizen officials, many of whom serve without reward, who hold
- 7 local government offices; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Local government also comprises thousands of
- 9 dedicated staff members who carry out the directives of the
- 10 local elected officials and who are supplemented by thousands of
- 11 tireless volunteers who serve on various local boards and
- 12 commissions; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's residents rely upon the dedication of
- 14 their local officials in meeting many of the residents' most
- 15 fundamental needs in nearly all facets of daily living; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Local government is the backbone of our democracy
- 17 and the bedrock of our political system; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The success of our local officials is a key element
- 19 in the overall quality of life in this Commonwealth; and
- 20 WHEREAS, It is fitting that each year in Pennsylvania one
- 21 week is set aside as Local Government Week and one day as Local
- 22 Government Day; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Local Government Week and Local Government Day focus
- 24 attention on the need for strong, independent and active local
- 25 government in this Commonwealth and recognize the valuable
- 26 contributions made by residents serving their communities;
- 27 therefore be it
- 28 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 29 week of April 13 through 17, 2015, as "Local Government Week"
- 30 and April 15, 2015, as "Local Government Day" in Pennsylvania;

- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commend and thank
- 3 the local officials of this Commonwealth for their labor as the
- 4 unsung heroes of government.
