## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of July 2016 as "National Auto Theft
- 2 Prevention Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration
- 4 holds an annual Vehicle Theft Prevention Campaign each July; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Vehicle theft is a very expensive crime, with the
- 6 cost of stolen vehicles estimated at more than \$4.1 billion; and
- WHEREAS, More vehicles are stolen during the month of July
- 8 than during any other month; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In 2014, there were 13,036 vehicle thefts reported
- 10 in this Commonwealth, averaging 36 thefts each day or 1 theft
- 11 every 40 minutes and 19 seconds; and
- 12 WHEREAS, That same year, 10,292 of the vehicles reported
- 13 stolen in this Commonwealth, or approximately 79%, were
- 14 recovered; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Local law enforcement found approximately 83% of
- 16 those recovered vehicles; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Between 2010 and 2014, a 21.8% decrease occurred in
- 2 the number of vehicle thefts, with fewer thefts reported during
- 3 each year of that period; and
- 4 WHEREAS, When leaving a vehicle unattended, simple steps can
- 5 be taken to prevent auto theft, such as making certain that all
- 6 windows are closed and doors are locked, hiding valuables from
- 7 view and etching the vehicle identification number (VIN) onto
- 8 the vehicle so that a criminal cannot change the VIN; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Vehicle theft happens in cities, towns and
- 10 communities of all sizes across this Commonwealth; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Individuals must continue to do their part to reduce
- 12 the number of vehicle thefts and increase the recovery rate for
- 13 vehicles reported stolen; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 15 month of July 2016 as "National Auto Theft Prevention Month" in
- 16 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives acknowledge the
- 18 importance of vehicle theft prevention and the need to help
- 19 reduce vehicle theft and other crimes in this Commonwealth.
