A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of August 2018 as "Spinal Muscular Atrophy Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Spinal muscular atrophy (SMA) is a rare genetically
- 4 inherited disease affecting the part of the nervous system that
- 5 controls voluntary muscle movement; and
- 6 WHEREAS, SMA is the leading genetic cause of death of infants
- 7 and toddlers, affecting one in every 6,000 to 10,000 people in
- 8 the United States; and
- 9 WHEREAS, One in every 50 Americans is a genetic carrier of
- 10 the disease; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Among autosomal recessive disorders, SMA is the most
- 12 common fatal disease and is second in birth prevalence only to
- 13 cystic fibrosis; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Symptoms in the mildest cases of SMA include muscle
- 15 weakness, muscle twitching and lack of muscle tone; and
- 16 WHEREAS, In the most severe cases, this rare disorder

- 1 interferes with one's ability to sit unsupported and causes
- 2 breathing and swallowing difficulties; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Early detection is vital to managing symptoms and
- 4 preventing SMA from progressing and interfering with one's basic
- 5 life functions; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The United States Food and Drug Administration
- 7 recently approved the first treatment for children and adults
- 8 with SMA; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Improving the length and quality of life for
- 10 individuals with SMA starts with awareness; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 12 month of August 2018 as "Spinal Muscular Atrophy Awareness
- 13 Month" in Pennsylvania.
