## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of June 1 through 7, 2018, as "Automated External Defibrillator Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, AED is the acronym for automated external
- 4 defibrillator; and
- 5 WHEREAS, AEDs are portable medical devices that use
- 6 electrodes to automatically analyze and detect cardiac
- 7 arrhythmia of sudden cardiac arrest patients; and
- 8 WHEREAS, AEDs are able to produce an electric shock which
- 9 stops the heart and allows it to return to a normal rhythm, a
- 10 process called defibrillation; and
- 11 WHEREAS, AEDs are used in the event of a sudden cardiac
- 12 arrest, a condition in which the heart suddenly stops pumping
- 13 blood and quivers erratically; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Approximately 360,000 cases of sudden cardiac arrest
- 15 occur yearly, typically without any warning signs; and
- 16 WHEREAS, An individual has approximately a 5% chance of

- 1 surviving an incident of cardiac arrest, which decreases 7% to
- 2 10% with every minute that passes after an individual's heart
- 3 stops beating; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Having an AED readily available increases the
- 5 likelihood that an individual can retrieve the AED and return to
- 6 the victim within 90 seconds; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Given that an individual's chances of surviving a
- 8 sudden cardiac arrest decrease so rapidly, it is important that
- 9 AEDs are readily available; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 11 week of June 1 through 7, 2018, as "Automated External
- 12 Defibrillator Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.
