A RESOLUTION

Honoring the lives and service of peace officers who lost their 1 lives in the line of duty in the year 2020 and extending 2 condolences to their families and friends. 3 WHEREAS, 36 U.S.C. § 136 authorizes the President of the 4 United States to designate May 15 of each year as "Peace 5 6 Officers Memorial Day" in honor of Federal, state and local 7 officers killed or disabled in the line of duty; and WHEREAS, 36 U.S.C. § 137 authorizes the President of the 8 9 United States to designate the calendar week in which May 15 occurs as "Police Week"; and 10 11 WHEREAS, On May 4, 1963, President John F. Kennedy, by 12 proclamation, designated May 15 of each year as "Peace Officers 13 Memorial Day" and the week in which May 15 occurs as "Police 14 Week" for 1963 and each succeeding calendar year; and WHEREAS, In 1998, the Congress of the United States reenacted 15

36 U.S.C. §§ 136 and 137 as part of the Patriotic and National
 Observances Codification; and

3 WHEREAS, Each year across the United States, May 15 is recognized as "Peace Officers Memorial Day," and the week it 4 occurs in is recognized as "Police Week"; and 5 6 WHEREAS, During the 2020 calendar year, 12 peace officers in 7 this Commonwealth died in the line of duty; and 8 WHEREAS, On January 2, 2020, Police Officer Michael L. Henry, 9 Jr., died from complications sustained in a motorcycle accident 10 while participating in an annual training course; and 11 WHEREAS, Officer Henry was a 25-year veteran of the Derry Township Police Department and a United States Army veteran; and 12 13 WHEREAS, On March 13, 2020, Sergeant James R. O'Connor, IV, was shot and killed while apprehending a homicide suspect; and 14 15 WHEREAS, Sergeant O'Connor was a 23-year veteran of the Philadelphia Police Department and a 15-year member of the SWAT 16 17 team; and

18 WHEREAS, On April 5, 2020, Captain James Walker died from 19 complications of COVID-19 after presumably contracting the virus 20 while on duty; and

21 WHEREAS, Captain Walker served 32 years with the Philadelphia 22 Police Department; and

23 WHEREAS, On April 11, 2020, Chief of Police Robert William 24 Sealock succumbed to complications of an asthma attack following 25 the foot pursuit of a wanted subject; and

26 WHEREAS, Chief Sealock was a United States Navy veteran and 27 served 23 years with the Aliquippa City Police Department; and 28 WHEREAS, On April 12, 2020, Interim Police Chief Mark J. 29 Romutis died from complications of COVID-19 after contracting 30 the virus while on duty; and

WHEREAS, Chief Romutis enjoyed a 43-year career in law
 enforcement culminating in becoming Interim Police Chief of the
 Ambridge Borough Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Chief Romutis also served with the Upper St. Clair
Township Police Department, Pittsburgh Police Department and
Ellwood City Police Department; and

7 WHEREAS, On June 3, 2020, Sergeant Jose Manuel Nova died from 8 complications of COVID-19 after presumably contracting the virus 9 while on duty; and

10 WHEREAS, Sergeant Nova was a 27-year veteran of the 11 Philadelphia Police Department, assigned to the 9th Police 12 District; and

13 WHEREAS, On June 6, 2020, Park Ranger Thomas E. Booz died 14 from complications of COVID-19 after presumably contracting the 15 virus while on duty; and

16 WHEREAS, Park Ranger Booz served as a park ranger with the 17 Bucks County Department of Parks and Recreation for 32 years; 18 and

19 WHEREAS, On June 13, 2020, Police Officer Dale Thomas 20 Provins, Jr., succumbed to injuries sustained when his patrol vehicle was struck head-on by an intoxicated driver; and 21 WHEREAS, Officer Provins was a 15-year veteran of the 22 23 Jefferson Hills Borough Police Department; and 24 WHEREAS, Officer Provins was a United States Marine Corps and 25 Pennsylvania Army National Guard veteran who served in Operation 26 Desert Storm and Operation Desert Shield; and WHEREAS, On November 23, 2020, Police Officer Tab Ali died 27

28 from complications of COVID-19 after presumably contracting the 29 virus while on duty; and

30 WHEREAS, Officer Ali was a 25-year veteran of the

1 Philadelphia Police Department, assigned to the 5th Police

2 District; and

3 WHEREAS, On November 28, 2020, Deputy Sheriff John J. "Sonny" 4 Kuhar, Jr., died from complications of COVID-19 after presumably 5 contracting the virus while on duty; and

6 WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Kuhar enjoyed a career in law 7 enforcement that spanned 60 years; and

8 WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Kuhar served with the Vintondale 9 Borough Police Department, Nanty Glo Borough Police Department, 10 Blacklick Township Police Department and Cambria County 11 Sheriff's Office; and

12 WHEREAS, On December 3, 2020, Captain Frank R. Milillo, Sr., 13 died from complications of COVID-19 after presumably contracting

14 the virus while on duty; and

15 WHEREAS, Captain Milillo served with the Philadelphia Police 16 Department for 31 years and commanded the Southwest Detective 17 Division; and

18 WHEREAS, On December 23, 2020, Sergeant Joseph M. Youse died 19 from complications of COVID-19 after presumably contracting the 20 virus while on duty; and

21 WHEREAS, Sergeant Youse served with the Philadelphia Police 22 Department for 39 years; and

23 WHEREAS, The bravery and selflessness demonstrated by the 24 fallen officers is exemplary and displays the service and 25 sacrifice of those who are tasked with protecting individuals 26 and institutions of democracy; therefore be it

27 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the lives 28 and service of peace officers who recently lost their lives in 29 the line of duty in the year 2020 and extend condolences to 30 their families and friends.
