1 2	Honoring educators and education support professionals in this Commonwealth for their efforts during the COVID-19 pandemic.
3	WHEREAS, Educators perform the critical role of educating
4	students in this Commonwealth; and
5	WHEREAS, Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the educational
6	process has completely changed requiring educators to adapt to
7	new ways of teaching and interacting with their students; and
8	WHEREAS, Educators have gone above and beyond their normal
9	duties to ensure that their students continue to learn and help
10	their students adjust to the changing environment; and
11	WHEREAS, Educators deserve to be acknowledged and applauded
12	for their efforts during the COVID-19 pandemic; and
13	WHEREAS, Many educators have delivered food and visited the
14	homes of their students; and
15	WHEREAS, In an effort to continue the educational process
16	while social distancing, some educators have even taught

1 students from their front lawns; and

2 WHEREAS, Administrators and teachers have been working 3 tirelessly to prepare for a safe school year and responding to questions and concerns from parents and school staff; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Educational support professionals, including food service workers, paraprofessionals, bus drivers, custodians and 6 7 maintenance personnel have played a critical role in supporting 8 students and meeting their needs since schools were closed last spring and will be critical in ensuring a safe return to school; 9 10 and

11 WHEREAS, Educators include nurses, counselors, psychologists, 12 social workers and others who are responsible for supporting the 13 full range of student health and wellness; and

14 WHEREAS, Educators have also continued their important role in reporting suspected child abuse; therefore be it 15 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor educators 17 and education support professionals in this Commonwealth for 18 their efforts during the COVID-19 pandemic; and be it further RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize 19 20 educators as heroes for their evolutionary and out-of-the-box thinking during this challenging time. 21
