A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of May 7 through 13, 2023, as "National Hospital Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The hardworking professionals of Pennsylvania's
- 4 hospitals and health systems ensure that every Commonwealth
- 5 resident can receive high-quality health care 24 hours a day, 7
- 6 days a week, 365 days a year; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Throughout the many waves and ever-changing
- 8 circumstances of the pandemic, opioid emergency and behavioral
- 9 health crisis, and despite the physical and emotional toll on
- 10 themselves and their families, Pennsylvania's hospital and
- 11 health system professionals never waiver in caring for our
- 12 communities; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Despite enduring the most challenging shared health
- 14 crises of our lifetimes, Pennsylvania's hospitals still provided
- 15 \$884 million in uncompensated care to members of our communities
- 16 in 2021; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's hospitals work to keep our families

- 1 whole and strong via, among other services, 50 trauma centers
- 2 that save more than 46,000 lives on average each year since 2016
- 3 and obstetric units that delivered nearly 125,000 babies in
- 4 2021; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth's hospitals provided 1.5 million
- 6 instances of in-patient treatment as well as emergency
- 7 department care more than 5.4 million times in 2021; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania takes pride in its 118 teaching
- 9 hospitals that are investing in the next generation of
- 10 lifesaving health practitioners and 40 hospitals that are
- 11 recognized with the prestigious "Magnet" designation by the
- 12 American Nurses Credentialing Center; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Hospitals are the largest employer in 18
- 14 Pennsylvania counties and among the top 10 employers in 41
- 15 additional counties; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Hospitals and health systems are responsible for 1
- 17 in 10 jobs across the Commonwealth, including more than 267,000
- 18 of our families, friends and neighbors directly employed and
- 19 more than 323,000 more supported by hospital-generated industry;
- 20 and
- 21 WHEREAS, Hospitals and their affiliated medical schools bring
- 22 close to \$2 billion in Federal health care research grants into
- 23 the Commonwealth and generate approximately \$168 billion in
- 24 other economic activity in State and local economies, accounting
- 25 for approximately 20% of Pennsylvania's gross domestic product;
- 26 and
- 27 WHEREAS, "National Hospital Week" celebrates hospitals and
- 28 the people who support the health of their communities with
- 29 dedication and compassion; and
- 30 WHEREAS, This observance is a reminder that hospitals are

- 1 foundations of the communities that built them, serving people
- 2 from all walks of life; therefore be it
- 3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 4 week of May 7 through 13, 2023, as "National Hospital Week" in
- 5 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives thank front-line
- 7 health care workers and hospital employees for their dedicated
- 8 service to the residents of Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge residents to
- 10 show appreciation to hospital workers for their devotion and
- 11 compassion even in the most difficult of circumstances; and be
- 12 it further
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge its members
- 14 to visit the hospitals in their communities to learn about the
- 15 innovative, quality care and services that are improving the
- 16 health and well-being of residents of this Commonwealth.
