## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of June 2018 as "Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, June is "Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month," and
- 4 the Alzheimer's Association seeks support to raise awareness of
- 5 this debilitating disease and the need to increase efforts to
- 6 combat its human and economic costs; and
- WHEREAS, The summer solstice, June 21, 2018, has been
- 8 declared the longest day, with teams around the world coming
- 9 together to honor the strength, passion and endurance of
- 10 individuals facing Alzheimer's disease with a day of activity
- 11 and advocacy; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Every individual in our communities is at risk for
- 13 developing Alzheimer's, a fatal disease that cannot be
- 14 prevented, treated or even slowed; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Worldwide, there are approximately 47 million people
- 2 living with Alzheimer's and other dementias, including more than
- 3 5 million living in the United States and more than 400,000
- 4 living in Pennsylvania, and, without a change, these worldwide
- 5 numbers are expected to grow to 76 million by 2030; and
- 6 WHEREAS, An estimated 5.5 million people who are 65 years of
- 7 age or older and approximately 200,000 people who are under 65
- 8 years of age live with Alzheimer's; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Alzheimer's is the sixth leading cause of death in
- 10 the United States, and one in three seniors dies with
- 11 Alzheimer's or another dementia; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Only 45% of individuals with Alzheimer's disease or
- 13 their caregivers report being told of their diagnosis, while
- 14 more than 90% of individuals with the four most common types of
- 15 cancer have been told of their diagnosis; and
- 16 WHEREAS, During 2017 in the United States, 16.1 million
- 17 family members and friends provided 18.4 billion hours of unpaid
- 18 care to individuals with Alzheimer's and other dementias and
- 19 that care had an estimated economic value of \$232.1 billion; and
- 20 WHEREAS, In 2017, Pennsylvania had an estimated 675,000
- 21 Alzheimer's and dementia family caregivers providing 769 million
- 22 hours of unpaid care valued at more than \$9.7 billion; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Researchers in Pennsylvania and around the world
- 24 continue their efforts to develop scientific breakthroughs that
- 25 could one day bring about a world without Alzheimer's disease;
- 26 and
- 27 WHEREAS, The individuals, families, friends and caregivers
- 28 dealing with Alzheimer's disease and the researchers who are
- 29 seeking a cause or cure should be recognized; and
- 30 WHEREAS, The efforts of the Alzheimer's Association to raise

- 1 funds and promote awareness to fight Alzheimer's disease and
- 2 other dementias improve the quality of human life for
- 3 individuals living with Alzheimer's disease and their
- 4 caregivers; therefore be it
- 5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 6 month of June 2018 as "Alzheimer's Disease and Brain Awareness
- 7 Month" in Pennsylvania.
