7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The sum of \$74,480,000, or as much thereof as may
10	be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Professional
11	Licensure Augmentation Account within the General Fund to the
12	Department of State for the operation of the Bureau of
13	Professional and Occupational Affairs for the fiscal year July
14	1, 2024, to June 30, 2025.
15	Section 2. (a) The sum of \$11,240,000, or as much thereof
16	as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted
17	receipts account of the State Board of Medicine for the
18	operation of the board for the fiscal year July 1, 2024, to June
19	30, 2025.
20	(b) The sum of \$3,194,000, or as much thereof as may be

necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted receipts
account of the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine for the
operation of the board for the fiscal year July 1, 2024, to June
30, 2025.

5 (c) The sum of \$442,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted receipts 6 7 account of the State Board of Podiatry for the operation of the 8 board for the fiscal year July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025. 9 The sum of \$908,000, or as much thereof as may be (d) 10 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Athletic Commission Augmentation Account for the State Athletic Commission, as 11 12 authorized by 5 Pa.C.S. § 1512 (relating to Athletic Commission 13 Augmentation Account), for the support and operation of the 14 commission for the fiscal year July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025. 15 (e) Each appropriation listed in subsections (a), (b), (c) 16 and (d) shall not be treated as an augmentation to the

17 Department of State, a general government appropriation or any 18 other appropriation, but shall be treated and accounted for as 19 separate appropriations respectively.

20 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024, or 21 immediately, whichever is later.
