16	(vi) For fiscal year 2018 and each fiscal year
17	thereafter, the limousine assessment shall not exceed 1%
18	of the annual gross revenue generated by a limousine

	<u>owner providing limousine service in a city of the first</u>
2	class and an airport in the city of the first class.
3	(vii) The limousine assessment under subparagraph
4	(vi) shall be collected from the rates for providing
5	limousine service in a city of the first class and an
6	airport in the city of the first class and shall not
7	<u>include tips or tolls.</u>
8	(viii) The limousine assessment under subparagraph
9	(vi) may be payable to the authority in a lump sum or on
10	a quarterly basis. The first quarter shall begin on July
11	1 and end on September 30 of each year. The second
12	quarter shall begin on October 1 and end on December 31
13	of each year. The third quarter shall begin on January 1
14	and end on March 31 of each year. The fourth quarter
15	shall begin on April 1 and end on June 30 of each
16	year. Payment under this subparagraph shall be due within
17	30 days after service of the notice of assessment from
18	the authority.
