- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in Pennsylvania National Guard,
- 3 providing for vaccine exclusion.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 2318. Vaccine exclusion.
- 9 (a) Prohibition.--No member of the Pennsylvania National
- 10 Guard may be required to receive a COVID-19 vaccine. No
- 11 administrative or legal actions may be taken against a member of
- 12 the Pennsylvania National Guard based solely on the member's
- 13 <u>refusal to receive a COVID-19 vaccine.</u>
- 14 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 15 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 16 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 17 "COVID-19." The novel coronavirus as identified in the
- 18 Governor's proclamation of disaster emergency issued on March 6,

- 1 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020).
- 2 <u>"COVID-19 vaccine." A vaccine for COVID-19 that has received</u>
- 3 emergency use authorization or approval from the United States
- 4 Food and Drug Administration.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
