AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An  
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain  
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial  
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the  
5 laws relating thereto," in school health services, further  
6 providing for health records.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 1402(b) of the act of March 10, 1949  
10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,  
11 repealed and added July 15, 1957 (P.L.937, No.404), is amended  
12 to read:

13 Section 1402. Health Services.--\* \* \*

14 (b) For each child of school age, a comprehensive health  
15 record, including medical and dental records, shall be  
16 maintained by the school district or joint school board[, which  
17 shall include the]. Each child's record shall contain:

18 (1) The results of the tests, measurements and regularly  
19 scheduled examinations and special examinations herein  
20 specified.

1       (2) All other information a school obtains concerning the  
2 health of the child, including information reported consistent  
3 with 23 Pa C.S. § 6340(a)(12) (relating to release of information  
4 in confidential reports).

6       Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
