- 1 Amending the act of December 4, 1996 (P.L.911, No.147), entitled
- "An act providing for registration requirements for
- telemarketers and for powers and duties of the Office of
- Attorney General," further prohibiting unwanted telephone
- 5 solicitation calls.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 5.2(c) of the act of December 4, 1996
- 9 (P.L.911, No.147), known as the Telemarketer Registration Act,
- 10 is amended to read:
- 11 Section 5.2. Unwanted telephone solicitation calls prohibited.
- 12 * * *
- 13 (c) Duration.--A listing on a do-not-call list shall be
- 14 maintained [for a minimum of five years from the date of the
- 15 enrollment or] until the telephone number is no longer valid for
- 16 the residential or wireless telephone subscriber[, whichever
- 17 occurs first] or until the subscriber requests to have the

- 1 <u>subscriber's telephone number removed from the list</u>.

- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
