## AN ACT

7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
9	as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding a section to

11	Section 438. Waiver to Purchase Diapers or Menstrual Hygiene
12	ProductsIf, in accordance with Federal law, the Food and
13	Nutrition Service of the United States Department of Agriculture
14	creates and makes available to the states a waiver permitting
15	recipients of benefits provided under the Supplemental Nutrition
16	Assistance Program (SNAP) or the Special Supplemental Nutrition
17	Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC) to use their
18	benefits to purchase diapers or menstrual hygiene products,

1	including tampons, sanitary napkins or feminine wipes, the
2	following shall apply:
3	(1) If a waiver is made available for SNAP, the department
4	shall apply for the Federal waiver. If the waiver is approved,
5	the department shall adopt rules and make changes as necessary
6	to implement the waiver.
7	(2) If a waiver is made available for WIC, the Department of
8	Health shall apply for the Federal waiver. If the waiver is
9	approved, the Department of Health shall adopt rules and make
10	changes as necessary to implement the waiver.
11	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
