## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and administrative work of the 3 Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the 4 administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal 6 7 Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain 8 administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining 9 the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and 10 administrative officers, and of the several administrative 11 12 departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain 13 other executive and administrative officers; providing for 14 the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of 15 16 all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain 17 departments, boards, and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and prescribing the manner in which the 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 20 commissions shall be determined, " in Office of State 21 Inspector General, further providing for powers, purpose and 22 23 duties. 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 25 hereby enacts as follows: 26 Section 1.
