AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 43235, on that
2 portion of State Route 2012 over Alloway Creek, Mount Joy and
3 Germany Townships, Adams County, as the Michael Dillman
4 Memorial Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Michael Dillman Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings and declarations.--The General Assembly finds
9 and declares as follows:

10 (1) Michael Dillman, who worked for the Department of
11 Transportation as an equipment operator, suddenly lost his
12 life in a vehicle rollover accident on August 15, 2011.

13 (2) Mr. Dillman was the husband of Kimberly for 27 years
14 and father to Amanda and Alicia.

15 (3) It is most befitting that the memory of Mr. Dillman
16 be honored in a manner that captures his hard work in the
17 construction and maintenance of our State roadways, highways
18 and bridges and his dedication to the mission of the
19 Department of Transportation.

1 (b) Designation.--The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
2 43235, located on State Route 2012, also known as the Fish and
3 Game Road, in Mount Joy and Germany Townships, Adams County,
4 over Alloway Creek, is designated the Michael Dillman Memorial
5 Bridge.

6 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
7 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
8 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

9 Section 2. Effective date.

10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
