- 8 Section 1. Section 15 of the act of August 15, 1961
- 9 (P.L.987, No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage
- 10 Act, is amended to read:
- 11 Section 15. Application of Act.--This act shall have no
- 12 application to any of the following--
- 13 (a) Any public works subject to [the Walsh-Healey Act, the
- 14 act of June 30, 1936, chapter 881, 49 Stat. 2036, 41 USCA
- 15 sections 35-45, or the Davis Bacon Act, the act of March 3,
- 16 1931, 40 U. S. Code 276 (a).] 40 U.S.C. §§ 3141 (relating to
- 17 <u>definitions</u>), 3142 (relating to rate of wages for laborers and
- 18 mechanics), 3143 (relating to termination of work on failure to
- 19 pay agreed wages), 3144 (relating to authority to pay wages and

- 1 <u>list contractors violating contracts</u>), 3146 (relating to effect
- 2 <u>on other federal laws</u>) and 3147 (relating to suspension of this
- 3 <u>subchapter during a national emergency</u>) or 41 U.S.C. Ch. 65
- 4 (relating to contracts for materials, supplies, articles, and
- 5 <u>equipment exceeding \$10,000)</u>.
- 6 (b) A residential housing alteration, repair work or
- 7 rehabilitation project that is not subject to the wage rate
- 8 requirements under 40 U.S.C. §§ 3141, 3142, 3143, 3144, 3146 and
- 9 3147 due to being less than twelve units and that is funded, in
- 10 whole or in part, through the HOME Investment Partnerships Act
- 11 <u>(42 U.S.C. § 12721 et seq.).</u>
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
