A JOINT RESOLUTION

- Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for will of the people.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby resolves as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 6 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 7 That Article I be amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 30. Will of the people.
- 9 To ensure that the sovereign will of the people is always the
- 10 highest law of the Commonwealth, the legislative, executive and
- 11 judicial branches must execute their responsibilities within the
- 12 <u>clear meanings of the words and phrases in this Constitution and</u>
- 13 the Constitution of the United States and any amendments thereto
- 14 at the time of their writing.
- 15 Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed
- 16 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution:
- 17 (1) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of
- 18 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall

proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania.

Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of 4 5 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising 6 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution 7 8 of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this 9 Commonwealth at the first primary, general or municipal 10 election which meets the requirements of section 1 of Article 11 12 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania.
