## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 22, 2011 (P.L.586, No.127), entitled "An act providing for gas and hazardous liquids 2 pipelines and for powers and duties of the Pennsylvania 3 Public Utility Commission; and imposing civil penalties," 4 further providing for title of act and providing for powers of the Department of Environmental Protection and for duties 7 of a pipeline operator. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The title of the act of December 22, 2011 10 11 (P.L.586, No.127), known as the Gas and Hazardous Liquids 12 Pipelines Act, is amended to read: 1.3 AN ACT 14 Providing for gas and hazardous liquids pipelines and for powers 15 and duties of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission; 16 providing for powers of the Department of Environmental 17 Protection; providing for duties of pipeline operators; and 18 imposing civil penalties. 19 Section 2. - 8 <u>Section 202. Notification.</u>
- 9 The department shall require a pipeline operator to conduct a
- 10 <u>hydrological investigation of each identified aguifer in each</u>
- 11 construction zone in existence on and after the effective date
- 12 <u>of this section of a pipeline.</u>
- 13 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
