Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in inchoate crimes, further providing 2 for prohibited offensive weapons. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 908(c) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended and subsection (b) is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 8 9 § 908. Prohibited offensive weapons. 10 * * * 11 (b) Exceptions. --12 13 (4) This section does not apply to the possession of a 14 bump stock purchased or otherwise obtained by a person prior 15 to the effective date of this paragraph. 16 Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following 17 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this

- 1 <u>"Bump stock." A device attached to the butt of a firearm</u>
- 2 which increases the rate of fire achievable with the firearm by
- 3 using energy from the recoil of the stock to generate a
- 4 reciprocating action that facilitates repeated activation of the
- 5 trigger.
- 6 "Firearm." Any weapon which is designed to or may readily be
- 7 converted to expel any projectile by the action of an explosive
- 8 or the frame or receiver of any such weapon.
- 9 "Offensive weapons." Any bomb, grenade, machine gun, sawed-
- 10 off shotgun with a barrel less than 18 inches, firearm specially
- 11 made or specially adapted for concealment or silent discharge,
- 12 any blackjack, sandbag, metal knuckles, dagger, knife, razor or
- 13 cutting instrument, the blade of which is exposed in an
- 14 automatic way by switch, push-button, spring mechanism, or
- 15 otherwise, any stun gun, stun baton, taser or other electronic
- 16 or electric weapon, bump stock or other implement for the
- 17 infliction of serious bodily injury which serves no common
- 18 lawful purpose.

- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
