## AN ACT

16	(a) Logotype for veteran-owned small businesses. The
17	department, in consultation with the Office of Administration,
18	shall design an official logotype for use by veteran owned small
19	businesses in this Commonwealth. The logotype design shall use

1 the words: "Pennsylvania Veteran-owned Small Business."

2 <u>(b) Logotype for service disabled veteran owned small</u>

3 businesses. The department, in consultation with the Office of

4 Administration, shall design an official logotype for use by

5 <u>service disabled veteran owned small businesses in this</u>

6 <u>Commonwealth. The logotype design shall use the words:</u>

7 <u>"Pennsylvania Service-disabled Veteran-owned Small Business."</u>

8 SECTION 1. THE DEFINITION OF "VETERAN" IN SECTION 9601 OF <--9 TITLE 51 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA CONSOLIDATED STATUTES IS AMENDED 10 AND THE SECTION IS AMENDED BY ADDING DEFINITIONS TO READ: 11 § 9601. DEFINITIONS.

12 SUBJECT TO SECTION 9602 (RELATING TO REGULATIONS), THE 13 FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES WHEN USED IN THIS CHAPTER SHALL HAVE 14 THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION UNLESS THE CONTEXT 15 CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:

16 <u>"BUSINESS FEE." A FEE REQUIRED TO BE PAID TO THE</u>

22 "VETERAN." AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:

(1) HAS SERVED IN THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES,
 INCLUDING A RESERVE COMPONENT OR THE NATIONAL GUARD, AND WHO
 WAS DISCHARGED OR RELEASED FROM SERVICE UNDER CONDITIONS
 OTHER THAN DISHONORABLE[.]; OR

27 (2) IS ACTIVELY SERVING IN THE UNITED STATES ARMED
 28 FORCES, INCLUDING A RESERVE COMPONENT OR THE NATIONAL GUARD.

29 "VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS." AS DEFINED IN 62 PA.C.S. § 2201

2 SECTION 2. SECTIONS 9610 AND 9611(A), (B) AND (C) OF TITLE 3 51 ARE AMENDED TO READ:

5 AS USED IN THIS SUBCHAPTER, THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES 6 SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION UNLESS THE 7 CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:

8 "BUSINESS FEE." A FEE REQUIRED TO BE PAID TO THE 9 COMMONWEALTH OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION FOR STARTING OR OPENING 10 A BUSINESS WITHIN THIS COMMONWEALTH. THE TERM DOES NOT INCLUDE A 11 FEE FOR MAINTAINING LICENSURE OR OTHER REQUIREMENT FOR 12 CONTINUING TO OPERATE A BUSINESS.

13 "RESERVIST." A MEMBER OF A UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES14 RESERVE COMPONENT OR NATIONAL GUARD.

15 "RESERVIST-OWNED SMALL BUSINESS." A BUSINESS OWNED AND 16 CONTROLLED BY A MEMBER OF A UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES RESERVE 17 COMPONENT OR NATIONAL GUARD.]

18 § 9611. EXEMPTION.

19 (A) PAYMENT.--A VETERAN-OWNED [OR RESERVIST-OWNED] SMALL20 BUSINESS SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE PAYMENT OF A BUSINESS FEE.

(B) PROOF.--A VETERAN [OR RESERVIST] MUST PROVIDE THE
DEPARTMENT OR LICENSING AUTHORITY OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION
WITH PROOF OF THE VETERAN'S [OR RESERVIST'S] STATUS USING ANY OF
THE FOLLOWING WITH ANY BUSINESS APPLICATION:

26 (2) A COPY OF A FEDERAL NGB-22 FORM.

27 (3) A VALID FEDERAL VETERANS' ADMINISTRATION CARD.

30 (C) STATUS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE OR LICENSING AUTHORITY

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1	OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION, IN CONSULTATION WITH OTHER
2	COMMONWEALTH AGENCIES, MAY DETERMINE AN APPLICANT'S STATUS AS A
3	VETERAN [OR RESERVIST] IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

15	(B) LOGOTYPE THE LOGOTYPE TO BE DESIGNED AND ISSUED SHALL
16	INCLUDE THE COMMONWEALTH COAT OF ARMS AND THE WORDS
17	"PENNSYLVANIA VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS."
18	(C) VERIFYTHE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE
19	DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES, SHALL USE THE VERIFICATION
20	PROCESS UNDER 62 PA.C.S. § 2202(A) (RELATING TO WOMAN-OWNED
21	BUSINESS, MINORITY-OWNED BUSINESS OR VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS) TO
22	VERIFY THE MILITARY SERVICE STATUS OF BUSINESS OWNERS SEEKING A
23	VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS LOGOTYPE.
24	(D) APPLICATION AND ISSUANCE THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A
25	LOGOTYPE WHEN THE VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS IS INCLUDED ON THE LIST
26	COMPILED AND MAINTAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES
27	UNDER 62 PA.C.S. § 2202(C) FOR VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESSES.
28	(E) NOTICETHE DEPARTMENT SHALL POST ON THE DEPARTMENT'S
29	PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE A NOTICE THAT THE
30	COMMONWEALTH LOGOTYPE IS AVAILABLE TO BUSINESSES PROVIDED FOR

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1	UNDER THIS CHAPTER AND SHALL INCLUDE THE CRITERIA NECESSARY TO
2	RECEIVE THE LOGOTYPE AND ALLOW FOR ACCESS TO THE APPLICATION AND
3	DIRECTIONS ON HOW TO SUBMIT THE APPLICATION.
4	(F) AUTHORITYUPON APPLICATION OF THE BUSINESS, THE
5	DEPARTMENT SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ISSUE, WITHOUT ADDITIONAL
6	VERIFICATION, A LOGOTYPE UNDER THIS SECTION TO A BUSINESS THAT
7	IS CURRENTLY APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES
8	UNDER 62 PA.C.S. CH. 22 (RELATING TO DIVERSE AND DISADVANTAGED
9	BUSINESSES).
10	(G) PENALTYA PERSON COMMITS A MISDEMEANOR OF THE THIRD
11	DEGREE IF THE PERSON FRAUDULENTLY HOLDS HIMSELF OUT TO BE A
12	VETERAN FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING A LOGOTYPE.
