AN ACT

1 Amending Title 74 (Transportation) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in turnpike, further providing for
3 annual hearing.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 8121 of Title 74 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 8121. Annual hearing and report.

9 (a) Public hearing.--Upon request, at least one commission
10 member shall testify at a public hearing before the
11 Appropriations Committee of the Senate and the Appropriations
12 Committee of the House of Representatives each year to present
13 information on turnpike operations and coordination with other
14 State agencies.

15 (b) Reports to General Assembly.--No later than September 1,
16 2022, and each September 1 thereafter, the commission shall
17 submit a report to the General Assembly summarizing toll
18 revenues that are collected and uncollected, and projected to be

1 collected and uncollected, including the reasons that the toll
2 revenues are uncollected, during the prior fiscal year. The
3 following apply:

4 (1) The report shall be submitted to the following:

5 (i) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
6 Transportation Committee of the Senate.

7 (ii) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
8 Transportation Committee of the House of Representatives.

9 (2) The report shall include the following information:

10 (i) The dollar amount of toll revenues collected and
11 projected to be collected during the prior fiscal year.

12 (ii) The dollar amount and percentage of toll
13 revenues collected and projected to be collected during
14 the prior fiscal year by collection method.

15 (iii) The dollar amount and percentage of tolls
16 uncollected and projected to be uncollected during the
17 prior fiscal year.

18 (iv) A breakdown of uncollected tolls detailing the
19 reason for failure to collect, including, but not limited
20 to, an unreadable or missing license plate, an
21 undeliverable address or an unpaid Toll By Plate mailer.

22 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
