8	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
12	section to read:
13	Section 1425. Cardiac Assessments of Participants in
14	Extracurricular Athletic Activities(a) A school district
15	shall require a student who is required under rule or policy of
16	the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association to receive
17	a physical examination before being allowed to participate in an
18	athletic activity sponsored or sanctioned by the Pennsylvania
19	Interscholastic Athletic Association to also have administered
20	to the student an electrocardiogram before being allowed to

1	participate in the activity, including a practice for the
2	activity, as follows:
3	(1) one time before the student's first year of
4	participation; and
5	(2) another time before the student's third year of
6	participation.
7	(b) Nothing in this section shall be construed as creating a
8	cause of action or liability against an appropriately licensed
9	or certified health care professional, a school district or a
10	district officer or employe for the injury or death of a student
11	participating in or practicing for an athletic activity
12	sponsored or sanctioned by the Pennsylvania Interscholastic
13	Athletic Association based on or in connection with the
14	administration or evaluation of or reliance on an
15	<u>electrocardiogram or on any echocardiogram.</u>
16	(c) The Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association
17	shall adopt rules as necessary to administer this section,
18	including a rule for granting a waiver from administration of an
19	electrocardiogram under this section to a student if, for any
20	reason, the parent of or person standing in parental relation to
21	the student submits a written request for the waiver.
22	Section 2. This act shall apply to the 2016-2017 school year
23	and each school year thereafter.
