## AN ACT

4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:

- 6 § 5401. Short title of chapter.
- 7 This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the
- 8 <u>Pennsylvania Premise Alert System Act.</u>
- 9 § 5402. Declaration of purpose.
- 10 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 11 (1) It is the policy of this Commonwealth to ensure that
- consistently high levels of public safety services are
- available to the citizens of this Commonwealth, including
- individuals who may require special consideration in order to
- 15 access services.
- 16 (2) The purpose of the Pennsylvania Premise Alert System
- 17 <u>is to provide individuals with disabilities with the same</u>
- 18 access to public safety services provided to all citizens of
- 19 this Commonwealth.
- 20 (3) It is the intent of the Pennsylvania Premise Alert
- 21 System to offer guidance and direction to public safety
- 22 agency employees in responding to and assisting those
- 23 individuals with disabilities whom they will have contact
- 24 with in the performance of their duties and responsibilities.
- 25 (4) The ability to effectively assist individuals with
- disabilities is enhanced with the information provided by the
- 27 Pennsylvania Premise Alert System.
- 28 (5) The Pennsylvania Premise Alert System helps identify
- 29 <u>individuals with disabilities and their places of employment,</u>
- 30 educational facilities and residences, which are valuable

- 1 <u>resources that help public safety agencies assist those</u>
- 2 individuals.
- 3 § 5403. Definitions.
- 4 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 5 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 6 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 7 "Computer-aided dispatch system." A database maintained by a
- 8 public safety agency or public safety answering point used in
- 9 <u>conjunction with 911 caller data.</u>
- 10 "Individual with disabilities." Any of the following:
- 11 (1) An individual who has a physical or mental
- 12 <u>impairment that substantially limits one or more major life</u>
- 13 <u>activities.</u>
- 14 (2) An individual who has a record of having a physical
- or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more
- 16 major life activities.
- 17 (3) An individual who is regarded as having a physical
- or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more
- 19 major life activities.
- 20 (4) An individual who has an increased risk for a
- 21 chronic physical, developmental, behavioral, emotional or
- 22 complex medical condition which may require health and
- 23 related services of a type or amount beyond that required by
- 24 individuals generally.
- 25 <u>"Pennsylvania Premise Alert System." A database of</u>
- 26 individuals with disabilities maintained by public safety
- 27 <u>agencies and developed through the use of the information</u>
- 28 provided by the Pennsylvania Premise Alert System Form and
- 29 <u>inputted into a computer-aided dispatch system.</u>
- 30 "Pennsylvania Premise Alert System Form." A form submitted

- 1 by an individual to a public safety agency that helps the public
- 2 safety agency and other emergency services personnel identify
- 3 individuals with disabilities in their places of employment,
- 4 educational facilities and residences.
- 5 "Public safety agency." Any of the following:
- 6 <u>(1) A municipal police department.</u>
- 7 (2) The Pennsylvania State Police, including all
- 8 Pennsylvania State Police barracks.
- 9 <u>§ 5404. Access Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency Form</u>
- and information.
- 11 The following apply:
- 12 (1) The Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency shall
- 13 <u>provide the Pennsylvania Premise Alert System Form on the</u>
- 14 <u>agency's publicly accessible Internet website. The</u>
- 15 <u>Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency may not alter the</u>
- form without the consent of the Pennsylvania State Police.
- 17 (2) A public safety agency shall make reasonable efforts
- to publicize the information regarding the Pennsylvania
- 19 Premise Alert System for use of the general public via a
- 20 publicly accessible Internet website, pamphlets or other
- 21 means available to the public safety agency.
- 22 § 5405. Duties of Department of Human Services and Department
- of Education.
- 24 (a) Department of Human Services. -- The Department of Human
- 25 Services shall:
- 26 (1) direct all caseworkers to offer a copy of the
- 27 <u>Pennsylvania Premise Alert System Form at the initial intake</u>
- of clients and annually at review meetings with individuals
- 29 <u>with disabilities and their caregivers; and</u>
- 30 (2) make reasonable efforts to provide the information

- in the Pennsylvania Premise Alert System to providers and
- 2 stakeholders.
- 3 (b) Department of Education. -- The Department of Education
- 4 shall:
- 5 (1) direct all school special education directors to
- offer copies of the Pennsylvania Premise Alert System Form to
- 7 <u>the caregivers of individuals with disabilities at the</u>
- 8 <u>initial individualized educational plan meeting of each</u>
- 9 individual with disabilities and each year thereafter until
- 10 graduation from high school; and
- 11 (2) notify all school nurses about the Pennsylvania
- 12 Premise Alert System and provide them with pamphlets to
- distribute to caregivers with information about how the
- 14 <u>system helps individuals with disabilities.</u>
- 15 § 5406. Duties of public safety agencies.
- 16 (a) Duties. -- A public safety agency shall have the following
- 17 duties:
- 18 (1) To accept the Pennsylvania Premise Alert System Form
- 19 from an individual who submits the form to the public safety
- agency and review the contents of the form upon acceptance.
- 21 (2) To maintain a copy of the Pennsylvania Premise Alert
- 22 System Form on file and transmit the form to the county 911
- center.
- 24 (3) To inform an individual who submits the
- 25 Pennsylvania Premise Alert System Form that submitting
- 26 information for input into the Pennsylvania Premise Alert
- 27 <u>System is entirely voluntary and will not result in</u>
- 28 preferential treatment by the public safety agency.
- 29 <u>(4) In the course of responding to an emergency</u>
- 30 involving an individual with disabilities, to inform the

- 1 individual with disabilities or caregiver of the individual
- 2 with disabilities about the Pennsylvania Premise Alert System
- and provide a copy of the Pennsylvania Premise Alert System
- Form or notice where the form can be accessed.
- 5 (b) Prohibition. -- A public safety agency may not coerce an
- 6 <u>individual to provide information on the Pennsylvania Premise</u>
- 7 Alert System Form. The name of an individual with disabilities
- 8 may be excluded from the form submitted.
- 9 (c) Agency selection. -- If a public safety agency ascertains
- 10 that another public safety agency at a different location will
- 11 better serve an individual with disabilities based on the
- 12 information provided on the Pennsylvania Premise Alert System
- 13 Form, the public safety agency shall forward the form to the
- 14 other public safety agency in a timely manner.
- 15 § 5407. Dissemination of Pennsylvania Premise Alert System
- information.
- 17 (a) Information dissemination. -- In the course of handling an
- 18 emergency or 911 call pertaining to an individual with
- 19 <u>disabilities</u>, a <u>dispatcher</u> at a <u>county</u> 911 <u>center</u> shall <u>relay</u>
- 20 any pertinent information in the Pennsylvania Premise Alert
- 21 System about the individual with disabilities to the responding
- 22 public safety agency.
- 23 (b) Emergency response. -- An employee of a public safety
- 24 agency or other emergency response organization responding to an
- 25 <u>emergency pertaining to an individual with disabilities shall</u>
- 26 make a reasonable effort to identify the individual with
- 27 disabilities and ascertain how to help the individual with
- 28 disabilities based on the information provided under subsection
- 29 <u>(a)</u>.
- 30 § 5408. Control of Pennsylvania Premise Alert System

- 1 information.
- 2 (a) Policies. -- A public safety agency shall develop policies
- 3 for the control and use of the information contained in the
- 4 <u>Pennsylvania Premise Alert System.</u>
- 5 (b) Information expiration. -- A public safety agency shall
- 6 <u>delete information submitted to the Pennsylvania Premise Alert</u>
- 7 System two years after the information is submitted, unless the
- 8 <u>information is updated via submission of a new Pennsylvania</u>
- 9 <u>Premise Alert System Form.</u>
- 10 § 5409. Confidentiality.
- 11 Except as otherwise utilized in accordance with this chapter,
- 12 the information in the Pennsylvania Premise Alert System shall
- 13 <u>be confidential. In accordance with Federal law, an individual</u>
- 14 may file a complaint with the Office of Civil Rights of the
- 15 <u>United States Department of Health and Human Services for a</u>
- 16 violation of this section.
- 17 § 5410. Liability.
- 18 Except for willful or wanton misconduct or a violation of
- 19 section 5409 (relating to confidentiality), an employee of a
- 20 public safety agency shall not be subject to civil liability for
- 21 failing to comply with provisions of this chapter.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
