AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 286
2 over the Two Lick Creek, at the east end of the Borough of
3 Clymer, Indiana County, as the Lance Corporal Joshua T. Twigg
4 Memorial Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Lance Corporal Joshua T. Twigg Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
9 follows:

10 (1) Lance Corporal Joshua T. Twigg was born on October
11 1, 1988, in Indiana, Pennsylvania, and grew up in Clymer
12 where he attended Penns Manor High School.

13 (2) Lance Corporal Joshua T. Twigg served his country
14 honorably with the United States Marine Corps 2nd Battalion,
15 9th Marine Regiment, 2nd Marine Division.

16 (3) On September 2, 2010, Lance Corporal Twigg was
17 killed in action in Helmand Province, Afghanistan.

18 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on Pennsylvania Route
19 286 over the Two Lick Creek, at the east end of the Borough of

1 Clymer, Indiana County, is designated the Lance Corporal Joshua
2 T. Twigg Memorial Bridge.

3 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
4 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
5 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

6 Section 2. Effective date.

7 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
