AN ACT

- 1 Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 42 (Judiciary and
- Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 3 Statutes, in assault, providing for the offense of drug
- delivery resulting in serious bodily injury; and, in
- sentencing, providing for sentencing for drug delivery
- 6 resulting in serious bodily injury.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 10 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 11 § 2719. Drug delivery resulting in serious bodily injury.
- 12 A person commits a felony of the second degree if the person
- 13 <u>intentionally administers, dispenses, delivers, gives,</u>
- 14 prescribes, sells or distributes any controlled substance or
- 15 counterfeit controlled substance in violation of section 13(a)
- 16 (14) or (30) of the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64),
- 17 known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic
- 18 Act, and another person suffers serious bodily injury as defined
- 19 <u>in section 2301 (relating to definitions) as a result of using</u>
- 20 the substance.

- 1 Section 2. Title 42 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 2 § 9720.9. Sentencing for drug delivery resulting in serious
- 3 <u>bodily injury.</u>
- 4 The Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing, in accordance with
- 5 <u>section 2154 (relating to adoption of guidelines for</u>
- 6 <u>sentencing</u>), shall provide for a sentence enhancement within its
- 7 guidelines for an offense under 18 Pa.C.S. § 2719 (relating to
- 8 <u>drug delivery resulting in serious bodily injury). When</u>
- 9 <u>determining the gravity of the offense</u>, the commission shall
- 10 consider whether the controlled substance or counterfeit
- 11 <u>controlled substance was administered, dispensed, delivered,</u>
- 12 given, prescribed, sold or distributed in exchange for any
- 13 direct or indirect remuneration or consideration.
- 14 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
