1 2 3 4	Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in hunting and furtaking licenses, further providing for resident license and fee exemptions and for license costs and fees.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 2706(b) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 2706. Resident license and fee exemptions.

11	(b) Disabled veterans
12	(1) Any resident disabled veteran of any war or armed
13	conflict whose physical disability consists of the loss of
14	one or more limbs, or the loss of the use of one or more
15	limbs, or whose physical disability is considered total and
16	who meets all other qualifications of this title and is
17	otherwise mentally and physically fit, shall be issued a

regular hunting or furtaking license upon application to any county treasurer, without the payment of the license cost, if that person is domiciled in this Commonwealth. <u>The following</u> provisions shall apply:

5 [(2)] (i) The application for the issuance of this 6 license shall, in addition to the other information required 7 by the director, contain a statement that the applicant is a 8 war or armed conflict veteran and that his physical 9 disability was service incurred.

10 [(3)] (ii) The applicant shall produce the applicant's 11 discharge papers and a Department of Veterans Affairs 12 disability certification to the effect that the applicant 13 suffers total physical disability.

14 [(4)] (iii) If a disabled veteran who qualifies for 15 issuance of a license under this [subsection] <u>paragraph</u> 16 presents documentation to show that the qualifying disability 17 is permanent, the county treasurer shall issue the disabled 18 veteran a lifetime hunting or furtaking license.

[(5)] (iv) In a county where there is no county treasurer by virtue of a home rule charter or optional plan of government, the county official who performs the functions of a county treasurer and who has been designated an issuing agent by the commission shall issue licenses under this [subsection] paragraph.

(2) Any resident disabled veteran of any war or armed
conflict who is eligible for disability compensation as
determined by the United States Department of Veterans
Affairs and who meets all other qualifications of this title
and is otherwise mentally and physically fit shall be issued
a regular hunting or furtaking license at the cost of \$1 upon
