- 9 Section 1. The act of April 6, 1951 (P.L.69, No.20), known
- 10 as The Landlord and Tenant Act of 1951, is amended by adding a

- 12 Section 106. Effect of Declaration of Disaster Emergency .--
- (a) It shall be deemed unlawful for a landlord to do any of the 13
- following during a disaster emergency declared by the Governor
- under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to general authority of 15
- 16 Governor) due to an epidemic or pandemic:
- 17 (1) Evict or attempt to evict a tenant unemployed, separated
- 18 from employment or unable to find employment as a result of the
- declaration of disaster emergency. 19

- 1 (2) Without the express consent of the tenant, enter the
- 2 <u>leased premises for purposes of showing the premises to</u>
- 3 prospective buyers or tenants.
- 4 (b) A landlord found to be in violation of this section
- 5 <u>shall be subject to a penalty of not less than five hundred</u>
- 6 <u>dollars (\$500) per occurrence.</u>
- 7 (c) This section shall apply only to residential leaseholds
- 8 and not to commercial leaseholds.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
