AN ACT

- Amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the
 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for broadband
 services.

 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 hereby enacts as follows:
 Section 1. Title 68 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated

 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

- 13 <u>§ 8201. Definitions.</u>
- 14 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 15 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 16 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 17 "Broadband facilities." Wires, cables, materials, equipment

- 1 and other facilities, which are or can be used for the provision
- 2 of broadband services.
- 3 "Broadband services." As follows:
- 4 (1) Service that consists of or includes the provision
- 5 <u>of broadband that:</u>
- 6 (i) is used to provide access to the Internet; or
- 7 <u>(ii) provides computer processing, information</u>
- 8 storage, information content or protocol conversion.
- 9 (2) The term includes the provision of video services,
- 10 <u>voice over Internet protocol services, wireless services and</u>
- 11 <u>Internet protocol-enabled services.</u>
- 12 "Broadband service supplier." An electricity,
- 13 <u>telecommunications or Internet supplier or affiliate that</u>
- 14 constructs, owns or installs new broadband facilities to provide
- 15 broadband services, at wholesale or retail, through existing
- 16 electric infrastructure within an easement. The term includes
- 17 third parties with which the electricity supplier contracts,
- 18 licenses or otherwise enters into agreements with for the
- 19 installation, service or maintenance of broadband infrastructure
- 20 and provision of broadband services on behalf of the electricity
- 21 supplier or affiliate.
- 22 "Easement." A recorded or unrecorded right-of-way, easement
- 23 or similar property right acquired by eminent domain,
- 24 prescription or conveyance that is used or may be used for
- 25 transmitting, distributing or providing electric service by
- 26 utilizing electric infrastructure.
- 27 <u>"Electric cooperative corporation." As defined in 15 Pa.C.S.</u>
- 28 § 7302(a) (relating to application of chapter).
- 29 <u>"Electricity supplier." A person engaged in providing</u>
- 30 electricity, at wholesale or retail, including a public utility,

- 1 municipal corporation or authority or an electric cooperative
- 2 corporation.
- 3 § 8202. Broadband services.
- 4 (a) Broadband facilities. -- The following apply:
- 5 (1) An electric cooperative corporation or an affiliate
- 6 of an electric cooperative corporation may provide broadband
- 7 <u>services or construct, operate and maintain broadband</u>
- 8 <u>facilities through an existing easement owned, held or used</u>
- 9 <u>by the electric cooperative corporation.</u>
- 10 (2) Except as provided for under subsection (b), the
- 11 <u>attachment of broadband facilities shall not constitute a</u>
- change to the physical use of the easement, interfere with or
- impair any vested rights of the property owner subject to the
- 14 <u>easement or place an additional burden on the property or</u>
- interests of the owner.
- 16 (3) A broadband service supplier that is not an electric
- 17 <u>cooperative corporation may access and attach broadband</u>
- facilities within an electric cooperative's easement:
- 19 (i) if an electric cooperative or its affiliates
- 20 have attached broadband facilities to provide retail or
- 21 <u>wholesale broadband services; and</u>
- 22 (ii) subject to the terms of applicable safety
- 23 standards, the structural integrity of the electric
- infrastructure and the electric cooperative corporation's
- 25 rules and fees for the attachments.
- 26 (b) Exception. -- Subsection (a) (2) shall not apply to the
- 27 attachment of broadband facilities that are additional
- 28 freestanding or ground-based structures within the easement.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
