- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in selection and
- retention of judicial officers, further providing for
- 4 continuing education requirement.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 3118(a)(1) of Title 42 of the
- 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 3118. Continuing education requirement.
- 10 (a) Magisterial district judges.--
- 11 (1) Every magisterial district judge shall complete a
- 12 continuing education program each year equivalent to not less
- 13 than 32 hours per year in such courses or programs as are
- approved by the board. At least every six years, the program
- 15 shall include the identification of mental illness,
- intellectual disabilities and autism and the availability of
- 17 diversionary options for individuals with mental illness,
- intellectual disabilities or autism. On a frequency as
- determined appropriate by the board, the program shall

- 1 <u>include instruction on options available to indigent</u>
- 2 <u>defendants for failure to pay court costs, fines, restitution</u>
- 3 <u>or fees in summary cases.</u>

- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
