Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in criminal homicide, further 2 providing for the offense of murder. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2502(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 2502. Murder. 8 * * * 9 10 Murder of the second degree. -- A criminal homicide 11 constitutes murder of the second degree when it is committed 12 [while] by: 13 (1) a defendant [was] engaged as a principal or an accomplice in the perpetration of a felony[.]; or 14 15 (2) an accomplice of a defendant engaged as a principal 16 or accomplice in the perpetration of a felony and the 17 defendant intentionally, knowingly or recklessly disregarded 18 the risk that the death of another human being would occur as 19 a result of their participation in the perpetration of the

- 3 Section 2. Any person who is incarcerated in a State
- 4 correctional institution on the effective date of this section
- 5 for a violation of former 18 Pa.C.S. § 2502(b) (relating to
- 6 murder) committed prior to the effective date of this section
- 7 shall be entitled to a review by the court to determine whether
- 8 there is a need for a resentencing hearing given the changes to
- 9 former 18 Pa.C.S. § 2502(b). Persons deemed by the court to need
- 10 a resentencing hearing shall be resentenced in accordance with
- 11 law.
- 12 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
