AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled  
2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the  
3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the  
4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative  
5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,  
6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or  
7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or  
8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative  
9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and  
10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative  
11 officers, and of the several administrative departments,  
12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the  
13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive  
14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of  
15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and  
16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,  
17 and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and  
18 prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation  
19 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of  
20 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be  
21 determined," in powers and duties of the Department of  
22 General Services and its departmental administrative and  
23 advisory boards and commissions, further providing for  
24 transfer authority over Lieutenant Governor's Mansion.

25 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
26 hereby enacts as follows:

27 Section 1. Section 2402.3(b) of the act of April 9, 1929  
28 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is  
29 amended to read:

1 Section 2402.3. Transfer authority over Lieutenant  
2 Governor's Mansion.--\* \* \*

3 (b) [~~The Lieutenant Governor's Mansion, upon~~] Upon transfer  
4 of the property under this section, [~~shall be used for the~~  
5 ~~purposes of~~] the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs  
6 shall determine the use of the former Lieutenant Governor's  
7 Mansion and shall provide equivalent facilities space for  
8 supporting Pennsylvania's veterans programs and supporting the  
9 National Guard to include current and survivor families as part  
10 of the facilities master plan.
