[The Lieutenant Governor's Mansion, upon] Upon transfer 3 (b) of the property under this section, [shall be used for the 4 purposes of] the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs 5 shall determine the use of the former Lieutenant Governor's 6 Mansion and shall provide equivalent facilities space for 7 supporting Pennsylvania's veterans programs and supporting the 8 9 National Guard to include current and survivor families as part_ of the facilities master plan. 10 * * * 11
