AN ACT

- 1 Establishing the Performance-based Funding Council and providing 2 for its powers and duties.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Performance-
- 7 based Funding Council Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Council." The Performance-based Funding Council established
- 13 by this act.
- 14 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 15 Commonwealth.
- 16 "State-related university." The following institutions:
- 17 (1) The Pennsylvania State University.

- 1 (2) The University of Pittsburgh.
- 2 (3) Temple University.
- 3 Section 3. Performance-based Funding Council.
- 4 (a) Establishment. -- The Performance-based Funding Council is
- 5 established for the purpose of the development of a new system
- 6 to distribute funding to the State-related universities. The
- 7 system shall utilize performance-based metrics designed to
- 8 increase degree attainment, encourage affordability in higher
- 9 education, meet workforce needs and grow the economy.
- 10 (b) Membership.--
- 11 (1) The council shall consist of voting members
- 12 appointed under paragraph (2) and nonvoting members, who
- shall serve in an advisory role, described under paragraph
- 14 (3).
- 15 (2) The voting members of the council shall be:
- 16 (i) An individual appointed by the Governor.
- 17 (ii) An individual appointed by the President pro
- 18 tempore of the Senate.
- 19 (iii) An individual appointed by the Minority Leader
- of the Senate.
- 21 (iv) An individual appointed by the Speaker of the
- 22 House of Representatives.
- (v) An individual appointed by the Minority Leader
- of the House of Representatives.
- 25 (3) The nonvoting members of the council shall be:
- 26 (i) The President of The Pennsylvania State
- 27 University or a designee.
- 28 (ii) The President of the University of Pittsburgh
- or a designee.
- 30 (iii) The President of Temple University or a

- designee.
- 2 (4) An individual appointed under paragraph (2) may not
- 3 be employed by or serve on the governing body of a State-
- 4 related university or other university or college in this
- 5 Commonwealth.
- 6 (c) Chairperson. -- The voting members of the council shall
- 7 appoint a member to serve as the chairperson.
- 8 (d) Council meetings. -- The meetings of the council shall be
- 9 held bimonthly and at the call of the chairperson as necessary
- 10 and shall be conducted in accordance with the requirements of 65
- 11 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 (relating to open meetings).
- 12 (e) Quorum. -- A majority of the voting members of the council
- 13 shall constitute a quorum, and a quorum shall be required to
- 14 vote on actions to be taken by the council.
- 15 (f) Council actions.--A two-thirds vote of the voting
- 16 members of the council shall be required for all actions taken
- 17 by the council.
- 18 (g) Administrative and technical support. --
- 19 (1) The General Assembly shall provide administrative
- support, meeting space and any other assistance required by
- 21 the council to carry out the council's powers and duties
- 22 under this section.
- 23 (2) The department, the Pennsylvania Higher Education
- 24 Assistance Agency and the State-related universities shall
- 25 provide technical support, including data, research and other
- assistance required by the council, to carry out the
- council's powers and duties under this section.
- 28 (h) Powers and duties. -- The council shall:
- 29 (1) Consult with Commonwealth agencies and experts to
- 30 assist in carrying out the duties of this section.

- 1 (2) Hold public hearings at each one of the State-
- 2 related universities and receive input from experts and
- 3 interested parties, including parents and students.
- 4 (3) No later than March 31, 2025, develop
- 5 recommendations for a new system to distribute funding to the
- 6 State-related universities that utilizes performance-based
- 7 metrics and requires the reallocation of between 3% and 5% of
- 8 the amount appropriated in fiscal year 2023-2024 in each
- 9 subsequent fiscal year.
- 10 (4) No later than April 30, 2025, transmit the
- 11 recommendations to the Governor, the department and the
- 12 General Assembly, including draft legislation to implement
- 13 the new system to distribute funding.
- 14 (i) Performance-based funding metrics. -- The council shall
- 15 consider the following metrics when developing the new system
- 16 under subsection (h):
- 17 (1) A base level of funding to ensure ongoing
- 18 operations.
- 19 (2) Incentive funding.
- 20 (3) Performance thresholds.
- 21 (4) The four-year graduation rate for first-time college
- 22 students.
- 23 (5) The percentage of undergraduate students enrolled
- 24 who received a Pell Grant during the previous school year.
- 25 (6) The six-year graduation rate for students who are
- awarded a Pell Grant in their first year.
- 27 (7) The four-year graduation rate for baccalaureate
- 28 students.
- 29 (8) Student retention rates.
- 30 (9) Bachelor's degree production per 100 full-time

- 1 enrolled students.
- 2 (10) Net tuition and fees per 120 credit hours.
- 3 (11) Postgraduation employment rates and salaries,
- 4 including wage thresholds that reflect the added value of a
- 5 baccalaureate degree.
- 6 (12) The number of students enrolled and the number of
- 7 degrees attained in high-priority occupations in this
- 8 Commonwealth.
- 9 (13) The number of nontraditional students enrolled in a
- 10 program to up-skill or reskill in high-priority occupations
- in this Commonwealth.
- 12 (14) The number of high school students who are dual
- enrolled and the number of credits earned.
- 14 (15) The percentage of credits articulated.
- 15 (16) Other metrics provided by each State-related
- 16 university.
- 17 (17) Other metrics related to higher education that the
- 18 council deems appropriate.
- 19 (j) Withholding of payments. -- If the council fails to
- 20 transmit its recommendations to the department as required under
- 21 subsection (h)(4), the department shall withhold the payment of
- 22 money appropriated to each State-related university until such
- 23 time that the council transmits the recommendations to the
- 24 department as required under subsection (h).
- 25 Section 4. Effective date.
- 26 This act shall take effect July 1, 2024, or immediately,
- 27 whichever is later.
