6	Section 1. Section 1408(c) of Title 4 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 1408. Transfers from State Gaming Fund.

10	(c) Local law enforcement grants <u>The following apply:</u>
11	(1) Annually, the sum of \$2,000,000 shall be transferred
12	to the board for the purpose of issuing grants to local law
13	enforcement agencies to investigate violations of and enforce
14	laws relating to unlawful gambling in this Commonwealth. For
15	purposes of this subsection, the term "local law enforcement
16	agency" shall include the Pennsylvania State Police when
17	conducting unlawful gambling enforcement and prevention
18	activities in a municipality which does not have a municipal

1 police department and in which the Pennsylvania State Police 2 provide the municipality with primary police coverage. 3 (2) From the amount transferred under paragraph (1), the 4 sum of \$250,000 shall be transferred annually from the board to the Attorney General. The annual transfer is for the 5 6 purpose of issuing grants to district attorney offices to investigate and prosecute violations of and enforce laws 7 relating to illegal gambling involving animal fighting 8 prohibited under 18 Pa.C.S. § 5511 (relating to cruelty to 9 animals). The Attorney General shall publish quidelines in 10 the Pennsylvania Bulletin providing for application and award 11 of grants under this paragraph within 60 days of the 12 effective date of this paragraph. The initial transfer under 13 14 this paragraph shall occur on July 1, 2014, and subsequent 15 transfers shall occur each July 1 thereafter. The grants under this paragraph must be available in the 2014-2015 16 17 fiscal year and each fiscal year thereafter. * * * 18

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
