## AN ACT

1	Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled "An
2	act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and
3	brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and
4	changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and
5	restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession,
6	consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding
7	in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic
8	liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the
9	persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and
10	duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing
11	for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores,
12	for the payment of certain license fees to the respective
13	municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain
14	nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure
15 16	without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," in

26	for under this section, the following question may be placed on

1	the ballot in a township of the second class within a county of
2	the sixth class:
3	Do you favor the granting of liquor licenses for the
4	sale of liquor in the ward in Yes
5	of ? No
6	(2) The procedure for placing the question on the ballot
7	shall be identical to the procedure used for the other ballot
8	question regarding the granting of liquor licenses under this
9	section, except that the electors shall be from the ward
10	referenced in the ballot question. The consequences for a "yes"
11	or "no" vote on the ballot question shall be identical to the
12	consequences of a "yes" or "no" vote on the other ballot
13	question regarding the granting of liquor licenses under this
14	section, except that the consequences shall only be applicable
15	within the named ward.
16	(3) Nothing in this subsection shall preclude the electors
17	of a township of the second class within a county of the sixth
18	class from voting on a ballot question regarding the granting of
19	liquor licenses for the entire township rather than a particular
20	ward within the township.
