AN ACT

Amending the act of September 2, 1965 (P.L.490, No.249), entitled "An act providing for the licensing and regulation 2 of the business of transmitting money or credit for a fee or 3 other consideration by the issuance of money orders, by the sale of checks or by other methods; conferring powers and duties upon the Department of Banking and Securities; and 6 imposing penalties," further providing for licensee requirements and for agents. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. Sections 11.1 and 12(c) of the act of September 12 2, 1965 (P.L.490, No.249), referred to as the Money Transmission 13 Business Licensing Law, are amended by adding clauses to read: 14 Section 11.1. Licensee Requirements. -- A licensee shall: * * * 15 (7) (i) Collect a fee for each transaction sent to a 16 17 recipient outside the United States equal to ten percent of the 18 amount of the transaction. (ii) The fee under subclause (i) shall be remitted quarterly 19 20 to the department on a form as the department, with the

assistance of the State Police, may prescribe. All required

- 1 forms and remittances shall be filed with the department not
- 2 later than the fifteenth day of the month following the close of
- 3 <u>each calendar quarter.</u>
- 4 <u>(iii) The department shall transmit all fees collected under</u>
- 5 this clause to the State Treasurer for deposit into the Property
- 6 Tax Relief Fund.
- 7 (iv) In the case of any individual with a valid Social
- 8 <u>Security number or a valid taxpayer identification number, there</u>
- 9 shall be allowed a tax credit against the fee under subclause
- 10 (i) for any taxable year an amount equal to the aggregate amount
- 11 of fees paid by the individual.
- 12 (v) Every licensee or delegate of a licensee shall post a
- 13 <u>notice on a form prescribed by the department that notifies a</u>
- 14 customer that the customer shall be entitled to an income tax
- 15 credit equal to the amount of the fee paid by the customer for
- 16 the transaction under subclause (iv).
- 17 Section 12. Agents. -- * * *
- 18 (c) The written agreement shall contain at least the
- 19 following provisions:
- 20 * * *
- 21 (8) The agent shall collect all fees imposed under this act
- 22 on behalf of the person on whose behalf the agent is acting and
- 23 remit those fees within thirty days to the person on whose
- 24 behalf the agent is acting.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
