## AN ACT

- Amending Titles 3 (Agriculture) and 27 (Environmental Resources) 1
- of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in nutrient 2
- management and odor management, further providing for the 3
- Nutrient Management Advisory Board; and, in Agricultural
- Advisory Board, further providing for establishment of board, <-- FOR POWERS OF BOARD AND FOR REVIEW OF REGULATIONS. 5
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 510(a) and (d) of Title 3 of the 9
- 10 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 11 Nutrient Management Advisory Board.
- 12 Creation. -- There is created the Nutrient Management
- Advisory Board. The board shall consist of 16 members appointed 13
- by the chairman of the commission and approved by a two-thirds 14
- 15 vote of the commission. The members so appointed shall consist
- of [five] six active commercial farm owners or operators
- 17 representing the livestock, swine, meat poultry, egg poultry and
- dairy industry nominated by Statewide general farm 18

- 1 organizations, one veterinary nutrition specialist, one
- 2 representative from the feed industry, one representative from
- 3 the fertilizer industry, [one representative of commercial
- 4 agricultural lenders,] one representative of local government,
- 5 one representative of academia who shall be an agronomist or
- 6 plant scientist faculty member of the school of agriculture of a
- 7 Pennsylvania college or university, one representative of
- 8 academia who shall be an animal science faculty member with an
- 9 expertise in odor management from the school of agriculture of a
- 10 college or university within this Commonwealth, one hydrologist,
- 11 two citizen representatives who are not farmers and one
- 12 environmental representative, all of whom shall have sufficient
- 13 knowledge, experience or familiarity with agronomic practices,
- 14 nutrient management practices or odor management practices and
- 15 all of whom shall be residents of this Commonwealth. The six
- 16 active commercial farm owners or operators shall be nominated in
- 17 <u>a manner that provides representation of the northwest, north</u>
- 18 <u>central</u>, <u>northeast</u>, <u>southwest</u>, <u>south central and southeast</u>
- 19 regions of this Commonwealth, corresponding to the regions
- 20 served by the Department of Environmental Protection regional
- 21 offices. Two of the six active commercial farm owners or
- 22 <u>operators shall hold an active concentrated animal feeding</u>
- 23 operation permit as required by the act of June 22, 1937
- 24 (P.L.1987, No.394), known as The Clean Streams Law.

- 26 (d) Duties.--The board shall review and comment on all
- 27 commission proposed regulations[, the interim guidelines under <
- 28 section 504(2) (relating to powers and duties of commission) and
- 29 the interim criteria under section 504(5)] developed to
