AN ACT

1 Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in lobbying disclosure, further
3 providing for reporting.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 13A05(b)(3) of Title 65 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 13A05. Reporting.

10 (b) Content.--

11 * * *

12 (3) The following apply:

13 (i) In addition to reporting the totals required
14 under this subsection, the expense report must identify,
15 by name, position and each occurrence, a State official
16 or employee who receives from a principal or lobbyist
17 anything of value [which must be included in the
18 statement under section 1105(b)(6) or (7) (relating to

1 statement of financial interests) as implemented by
2 section 1105(d)].

3 [(ii) For purposes of this chapter, the amount
4 referred to in section 1105(b)(7) shall be considered an
5 aggregate amount per year.]

6 (iii) For purposes of this chapter, [the amount
7 referred to in section 1105(b)(7) shall not include] the
8 cost of a reception which the State official or employee
9 attends in connection with public office or employment
10 shall not be considered something of value.

11 (iv) Written notice must be given to each State
12 official or employee who is listed in an expense report
13 under this paragraph at least seven days prior to the
14 report's submission to the department. Notice under this
15 subparagraph shall include the information which will
16 enable the State official or employee to comply with
17 section 1105(b)(6) and (7). For purposes of this chapter
18 and Chapter 11 (relating to ethics standards and
19 financial disclosure), section 1105(b)(6) and (7) shall
20 constitute mutually exclusive categories. For each
21 category enumerated in paragraph (2)(i), each notice
22 shall include both the amount incurred during the quarter
23 and the cumulative amount incurred from January 1 through
24 the end of the applicable quarter.

25 (v) This paragraph shall not apply to anything of
26 value received from immediate family when the
27 circumstances make it clear that motivation for the
28 action was the personal or family relationship.

29 * * *

30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
