8	§ 3914. Specifications for contracts.
9	(a) Specifications for contractsA specification for a
10	contract awarded under this chapter may not require:
11	(1) a successful bidder or subcontractor to utilize only
12	workers who are:
13	(i) represented by a designated labor organization;
14	or
15	(ii) referred by a designated labor organization;
16	(2) a successful bidder's work force or any of its
17	subcontractors' work forces to affiliate with or pay dues to
18	<u>a labor organization; or</u>

- 1 <u>(3) a successful bidder or any of its subcontractors to</u>
- 2 <u>recognize a labor organization as the exclusive</u>
- 3 representative of any of its employees on the project.
- 4 (b) Discrimination prohibited.--A government agency may not
- 5 consider or use as a criterion in its selection process whether
- 6 <u>or not a bidder uses a unionized work force.</u>
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
