AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, in development, providing for prohibition of
- 3 natural gas hydraulic fracturing.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 58 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 3211.1. Prohibition of natural gas hydraulic fracturing.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Natural gas hydraulic fracturing is
- 10 prohibited in this Commonwealth in accordance with the
- 11 Constitution of Pennsylvania.
- 12 (b) Criminal penalties. -- A violation of this section shall
- 13 be a misdemeanor of the first degree.
- 14 (c) Administrative sanctions. -- In addition to any other
- 15 remedy available at law or in equity for a violation of this
- 16 <u>section</u>, the department may assess a civil penalty of up to
- 17 \$500,000 for each violation by a person. The department shall
- 18 use the following factors in assessing a penalty:
- 19 (1) Willfulness of the violation.

1	(2) Damage to the air, water, land or other natural
2	resources, or their uses, in this Commonwealth.
3	(3) Cost of restoration and abatement.
4	(4) Harm caused to the health and safety of affected
5	individuals.
6	(5) Aggravation of global climate change.
7	(6) Any other relevant factors.
8	(d) Liability Notwithstanding any other provision of law
9	to the contrary, an individual employed by a corporation that
10	violates this section shall be liable under this section if:
11	(1) the individual's conduct contributed to the
12	corporation's violation of this section; and
13	(2) the individual's contributory conduct was within the
14	scope of the individual's employment duties.
15	(e) Period of limitations
16	(1) A prosecution under this section must be commenced
17	within two years of the date of the alleged violation.
18	(2) An administrative sanction under this section must
19	be commenced within two years of the date of the discovery by
20	the department of the alleged violation.
21	(f) RegulationsThe department shall promulgate rules and
22	regulations necessary to carry out the provisions of this
23	section.
24	(g) Construction Nothing in this section may be construed:
25	(1) to bar an individual from bringing a civil action
26	against a person who has violated this section if the civil
27	action is commenced within two years of the discovery by the
28	individual of the cause of action; and
29	(2) to impose penalties against a person for actions
30	performed prior to the effective date of this section.

- 1 (h) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 2 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 3 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 4 <u>"Department." The Department of Environmental Protection of</u>
- 5 the Commonwealth.
- 6 "Natural gas hydraulic fracturing." The breaking of rock by
- 7 <u>fluid for the purposes of stimulating or extracting natural gas</u>
- 8 as part of a commercial effort to produce and sell energy.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall apply to acts committed on or
- 10 after the effective date of this section.
- 11 Section 3. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar
- 12 as they are inconsistent with the provisions of this act.
- 13 Section 4. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall submit a
- 14 notice to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in
- 15 the Pennsylvania Bulletin upon the ratification of a
- 16 Pennsylvania constitutional amendment that bans natural gas
- 17 hydraulic fracturing.
- 18 Section 5. This act shall take effect as follows:
- 19 (1) This section and section 4 of the act shall take
- 20 effect immediately.
- 21 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect upon
- publication of the notice under section 4.
