## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387), 1 entitled "An act prohibiting unfair methods of competition 2 and unfair or deceptive acts or practices in the conduct of 3 any trade or commerce, giving the Attorney General and District Attorneys certain powers and duties and providing 5 penalties," further providing for definitions. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 2(4) of the act of December 17, 1968 10 (P.L.1224, No.387), known as the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law, is amended by adding a subclause to 11 12 read: 13 Section 2. Definitions. -- As used in this act. \* \* \* 14 15 (4) "Unfair methods of competition" and "unfair or deceptive acts or practices" mean any one or more of the following: 17 18 (xxi.1) Failing to permit an individual who signed a contract for the provision of direct-to-home satellite 19

- 1 <u>transmission service to rescind the contract without penalty</u>
- 2 regardless of where the contract was signed, within seven days
- 3 of the date of signing and failing to provide the individual,
- 4 without charge, a completed copy of the contract at the time the
- 5 contract is executed which shall contain a notice explaining the
- 6 <u>individual's right to rescind the contract. As used in this</u>
- 7 subclause, "direct-to-home satellite transmission" shall mean
- 8 the transmission, distribution or broadcasting of video
- 9 programming or services by satellite directly to the premises of
- 10 an individual who has subscribed to the programming or services
- 11 without the use of ground receiving or distribution equipment,
- 12 except at the premises or in an uplink process to the satellite.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
