To provide appropriations from the General Fund for the expenses 1 of certain agencies of the Executive Department for the 2 fiscal year July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close 3 4 of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 PART I 9 GENERAL PROVISIONS Section 101. Short title. 10 11 This act shall be known and may be cited as the General 12 Appropriation Act of 2024. 13 Section 102. State appropriations. 14 The following sums specified in this act, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are specifically appropriated from the 15 16 General Fund to certain agencies of the Executive Department of 17 the Commonwealth for the payment of salaries, wages or other compensation and travel expenses of the duly elected or 18

appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for the

payment of fees for contractual services rendered, for the

- 1 purchase or rental of goods and services, printing, public
- 2 advertising by or through any medium, equipment, land and
- 3 buildings and for payment of any other expenses, as provided by
- 4 law or by this act, necessary for the proper conduct of the
- 5 duties, functions and activities and for the purposes specified
- 6 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and for the payment
- 7 of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the
- 8 fiscal year ending June 30, 2024.

- 26 Section 8102. Effective date.
- 27 This act shall take effect July 1, 2024, or immediately,
- 28 whichever is later.
